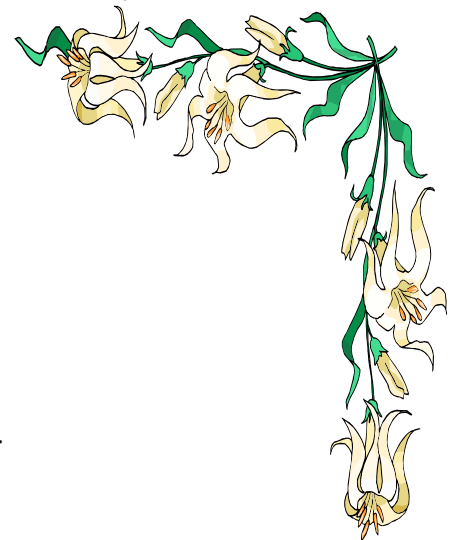
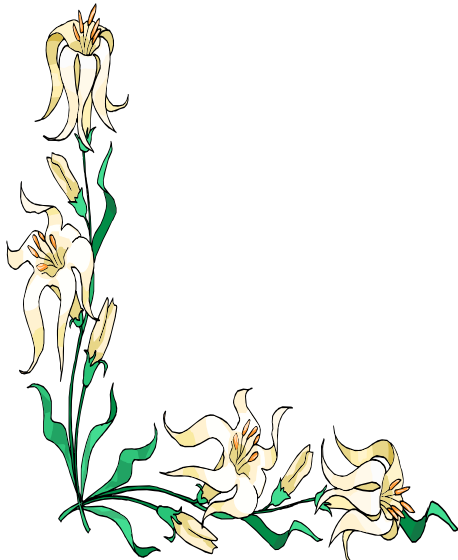


Second Sunday of Easter Divine Mercy Sunday

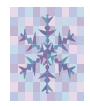

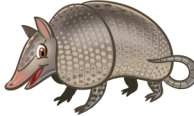
