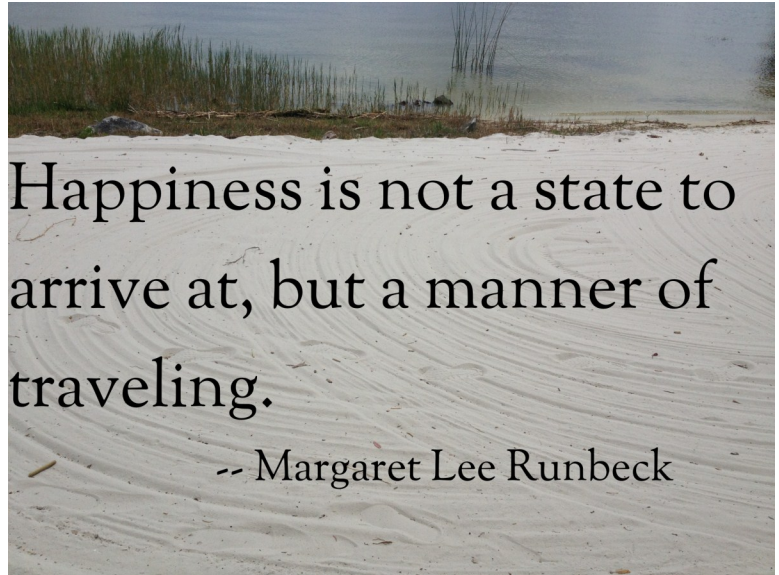

Adult Esperanza Trek 2013

You must have kept us in prayer! Not one injury on the job site. We worked our first day in Morita (where we have worked on over 1/2 the total homes built since 1992). We had a 3 level scaffold and mixed, passed, lifted and poured 47 loads of cement to finish a wonderful roof. We were aided by community members including Anna, the owner of "Vern Endres' House".

Days 2—5, we worked in a new community just north of Rosarito. Norma spoke some English, which is helpful for our 'elder group'. We mixed and formed 680 cement blocks AND dug a 52inch foundation 12x 22 feet.

The 23 adult trekkers totaled 227 week long trips. We are committed to the model of community development that Esperanzaint.org represents.
