On June 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> Fr. Tom Marti, will visit and celebrate all the weekend Masses. He will be doing a missions appeal for the Maryknoll congregation to support their ministry in different parts of the world, offering and bringing the word of God to all peoples. The Maryknoll society is made up ordinary men sent to people of different histories, traditions and cultures sharing the good news of Christ. Maryknoll depends solely upon the American Catholic church for support. All gifts received are used for mission work, education, recruitment, training and for the care of ill and retired missionary. And so during that weekend a second collection will be collected to help support the Maryknoll Priests and brothers. Thank you for your generous response.
