Just last week we were able to raise \$21,916 of the \$83,522 goal that was assigned to us. We are off to a good start but we are still a long ways from reaching our goal and so I again would like to make an appeal to you to please help support our church. As what was mentioned last week any monies we collect over our goal would be returned to us as a rebate which we can use to cover some of the expenses we incur, for this year we plan to change the walkway lights as people have brought their concerns to us during last winter telling us how dark it is. However if we do not meet our goal we would be asked by the archdiocese to fill-in whatever is lacking in our quota. So please help us meet our goal.

On another note next weekend, we will be having our Mother's day celebration and May crowning. At each of the Masses the Knights of Columbus will be handing out corsages to all the mothers in the congregation also on the 10:30 Mass, there will be a procession in honor of the Blessed Virgin Mary at 9:30 beginning inside the church and going around the property and ending with a celebration of the liturgy. After the Mass there will be a reception in the Social Hall hosted by the Filipino Community. So please come and join us. God bless!

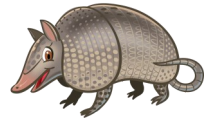
