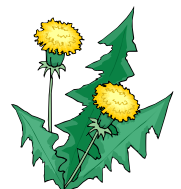

August 4 — 10 Youth Migrant Project in the Skagit Valley Would you be available to chaperone this wonderful week of service to our neighbors? Permission slips are out. **LOW Cost of \$300 all inclusive-**

Esperanza report 4/5 of the way finished. Goodwin group bringing in the finish 5th week. May Adult trek found 23 SJV folks pouring a roof in Morita day 1, then working on the first home in the brand new Rosarito community. Norma, the recipient, is in her mid 50's and cares for 3 siblings in their mid to late 60's 2 of whom are developmentally disabled. Adults wielded picks and shovels to dig the footings, made 800 concrete blocks, and actually moved a house! The college trekkers completed the block laying, rebar & wires, and poured the footing. Our high school group, using the adult perfect blocks, built the walls, created the frame cages, and on our final day poured a 56 bag roof. SJV built what Norma called "casa de amor". Words cannot adequately express the joy we all felt at closure. Thanks to ALL SJV folks who continue to support. "If God wants you to fly Alaska Airlines..." Our youth group had United group tickets as the fare was \$140 less per ticket than Alaska (which we flew 22 yrs straight). Outbound, our plane was grounded which meant our San Fran flight was missed. United gave us each \$30 in food vouchers, flew us on ALASKA flight 9 pm, and bought us 8 hotel rooms in San Diego so we weren't crossing the border at midnight. Flash to return flight on United, terrible crash in San Fran, again United puts us on Alaska flights leaving San Diego direct to SEATAC and we all came back early.
