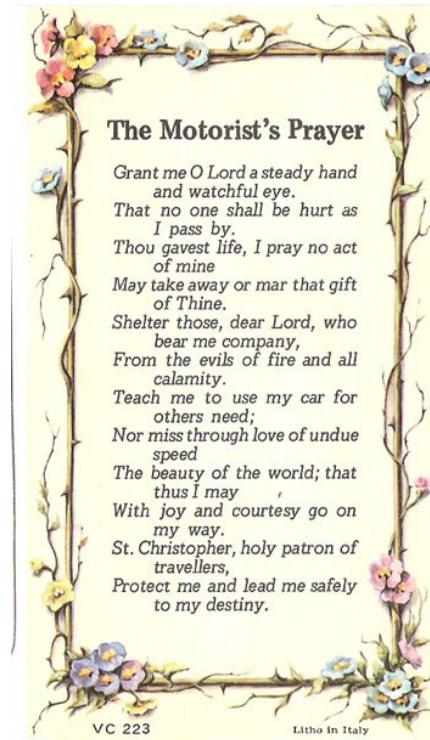

If you have extra toothbrushes, soap, shampoo or hand sanitizers please donate them in the picnic basket by the upstairs restrooms.

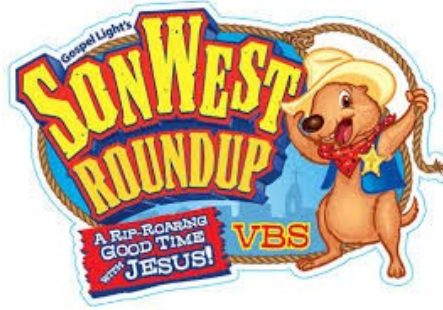
They will be taken by the **Serra Club** to Lazarus House along with sack lunches that they prepare for the homeless.
