Morning Prayer is part of the Liturgy of the Hours. It is a structured pattern of prayers that includes hymns, psalms, antiphons, Scripture, meditation, the Lord's prayer, and other readings and responses. The Liturgy of the hours follows a four week cycle, with adjustments for feasts and seasons of the Liturgical Year. When you think about the concept of Liturgy of the hours... the hours ring on from one time zone to the next. As Christians everywhere pray the liturgy of the hours, they are always passing prayer on to the next choir somewhere else around the world. At any one time, even if prayed alone, this prayer unites us with the Body of Christ.

Join us weekday mornings in the Parish Chapel at 8:30 am for Adoration, 9:00 am for Morning Prayer followed by Morning Mass. Be sure to grab a cup of coffee afterward in the parish social hall.
