'SVDP thanks the entire parish for their support in 2014, and most recently the Christmas Giving Tree & Food Basket Program. We helped make 62 families Christmas's be a lot brighter, by providing Christmas gifts and food for their holiday. That's a total of over 300 people, of which over 180 were kids. The generosity of our Parish is unmatched. Each family also got a gift certificate to go buy whatever perishable items they needed for their holiday dinner.

With the number of people we helped, our Pantry is now pretty low on non-perishable food for the start of 2015. We receive calls for help on a daily basis asking for financial help and pretty much each caller get some non-perishables also.
