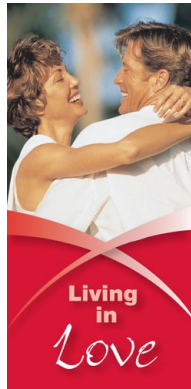

Pope Francis and the World Meeting for Families

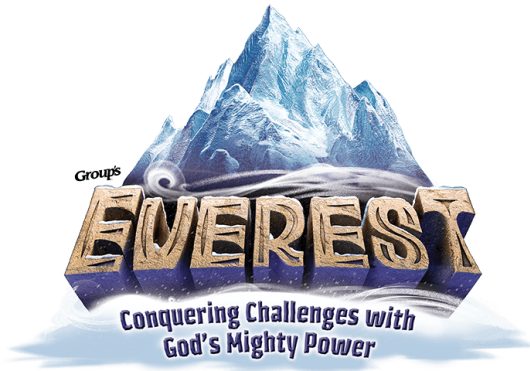
